In regards to Past Performance, it is <u>your responsibility</u> to mail out past performance questionnaires to your previous customer contacts, and ensure they are completed and returned the contracting POC no later than the closing date of the solicitation.

- In lieu of a Past/Present Performance Questionnaire, if a project is currently available in the Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) the contractor should attach the evaluation to the questionnaire with the relevant solicitation number and submit directly to the 1st Special Operations Contracting Squadron office before the official closing date and time.

Please note that CLINs 0001 and 1001 for the addition portion of the project will be SUBJECT TO STATUTORY COST LIMITIATION for minor construction and **SHALL NOT exceed \$2,000,000.00.**
